Regular Punch Card Voting System

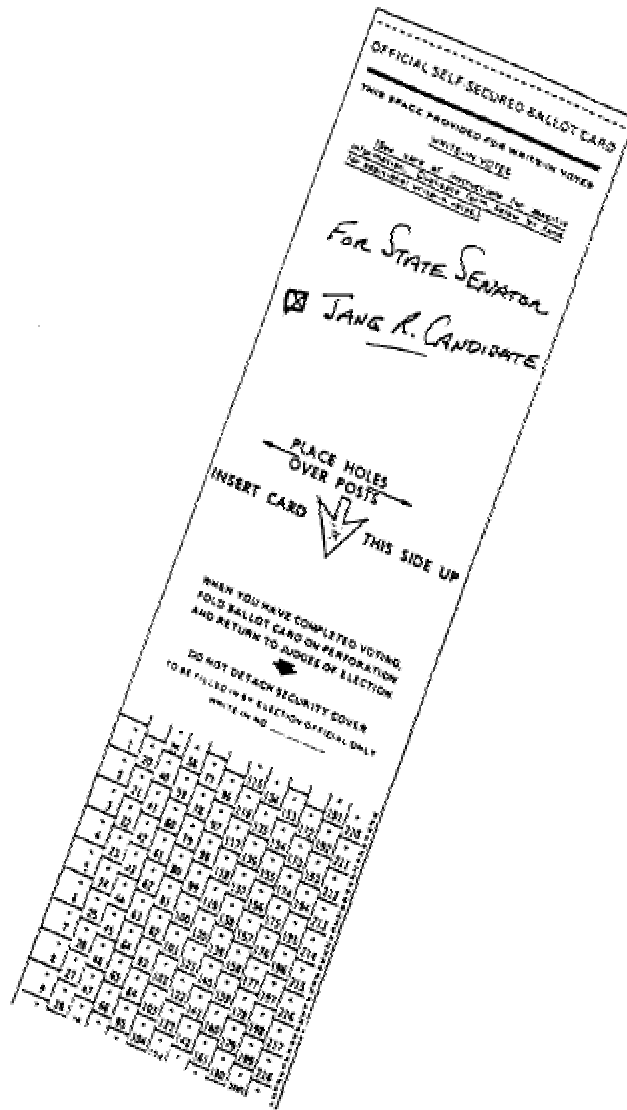
